1. Co-chair updates

- a. Associate Vice Chancellor, Facilities Management, Scott Turley
 - i. UA has submitted our 5.2MW project to the Public Service Commission.
 Entegrity is the partner with the UA on that project.
 - ii. 63MW UASYS RFP submissions were received on November 7. More to come on that.
 - iii. Entegrity is 80% complete on the campus-wide LED retrofit project
- b. Director of Sustainability Academic Programs, Ken McCown
- c. ASG Sustainability Director, Michael Dortch
- 2. UA 2022 Waste Data Update (Eric Boles)
 - a. By 2040 the UA plans to be net carbon neutral and have a 90% diversion rate from landfill.
 - b. The UA Waste streams are quite complex with all the contributing entities and types of materials being recycled/reused/disposed of and who is recycling/reusing/disposing them.
 - c. UA is currently at a 22% diversion rate: \sim 3700 tons to the landfill and \sim 1000 tons are being diverted.
 - d. Education, housing, and athletics all represent 1/3 of the UA waste.
 - e. Chartwell's numbers for composting and RFR have gone down because they have switched models from buffet to pre-prepared.
 - f. UA Surplus is trending positively, especially helping with the housing leave green program.
 - g. Full breakdown of the waste numbers by each entity is attached below.
- 3. Preliminary UA Commuter Survey Data (Ammen Jordan)

- a. Primary mode of travel has single occupancy vehicles at 40% for getting to the UA campus, and about 65% of respondents use multiple modes of transportation to get to campus, which is a very positive story for active transportation.
- b. Parking permit purchases trend with this data—about 40% of campus affiliates buy parking passes.
- 4. General natural surface trail updates (Ammen Jordan)
 - a. Fayetteville traverse is really a great connection with the broader community and destinations.
 - b. Daily traffic on the UA Traverse sections is about 100 users per day which is amazing for such a new trail
 - c. More data to come on trail use as the UA is procuring two more data collection portals.
 - d. The traverse will be wrapped up on campus in the next few weeks.
 - e. After hard rains and nearly a full football season, the trails have proven to be resilient.

- 5. Update on Chartwells Sustainability programs (Ashton Julian)
 - a. November is world vegan month and Chartwells is promoting plant based meals this month.
 - b. The released a vegetarian and vegan dining guide, available here.
 - c. Chartwell's also partnered with HowGood on the specific recipes they use on campus, which is a labeling system to show student the environmental impact of the food they are going to consume.




DIVERSION vs AVERSION








FY2022 Breakdown of Landfill Waste by UA Unit


FY2022 Rate of Diversion in UA Units



CHARTWELLS COMPOST AND RFR TONNAGE SUMMARY










UA Trash vs. Diversion Rates
