Background

In 2018, the City of Fayetteville adopted its [Energy Action Plan](#), which focused on steps the City could take to reduce the amount of greenhouse gas emissions generated throughout the community. Since then, the City has made significant energy improvements. This includes a 10-Megawatt solar power array, expanded sidewalk and trail infrastructure and a food waste composting program for Fayetteville residents.

Now, the City is developing a new, comprehensive Climate Action Plan. This plan continues the commitment to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and adds a new focus on nature-based solutions to help reduce the impacts of climate change.

Together, we can help make Fayetteville more sustainable and resilient.

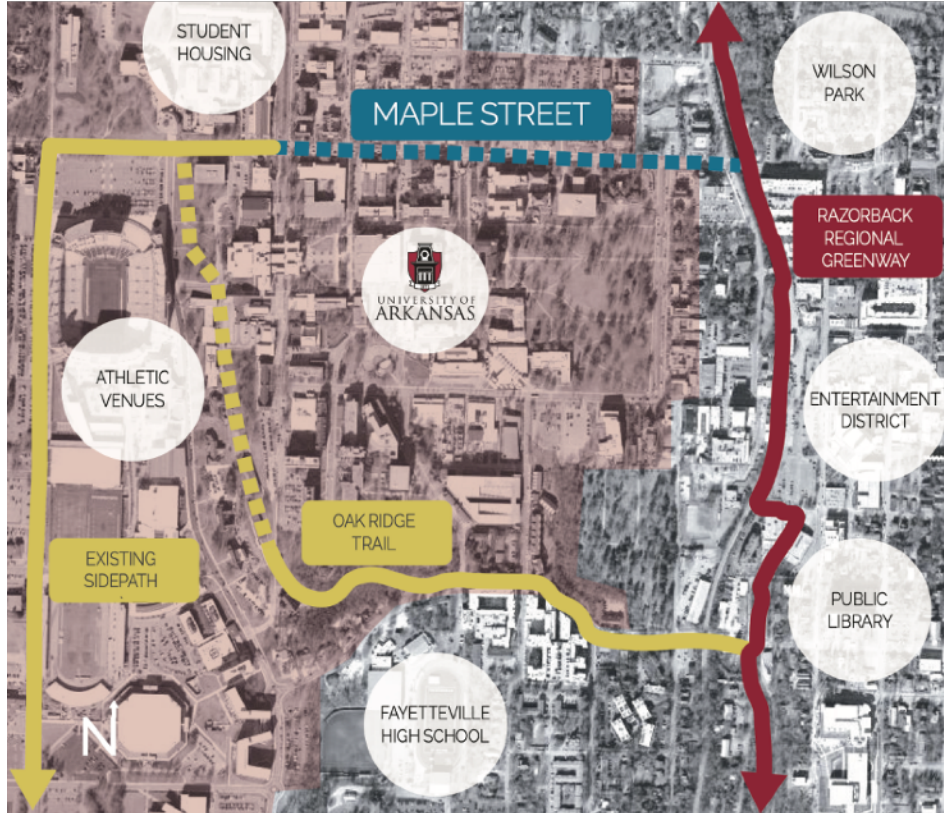

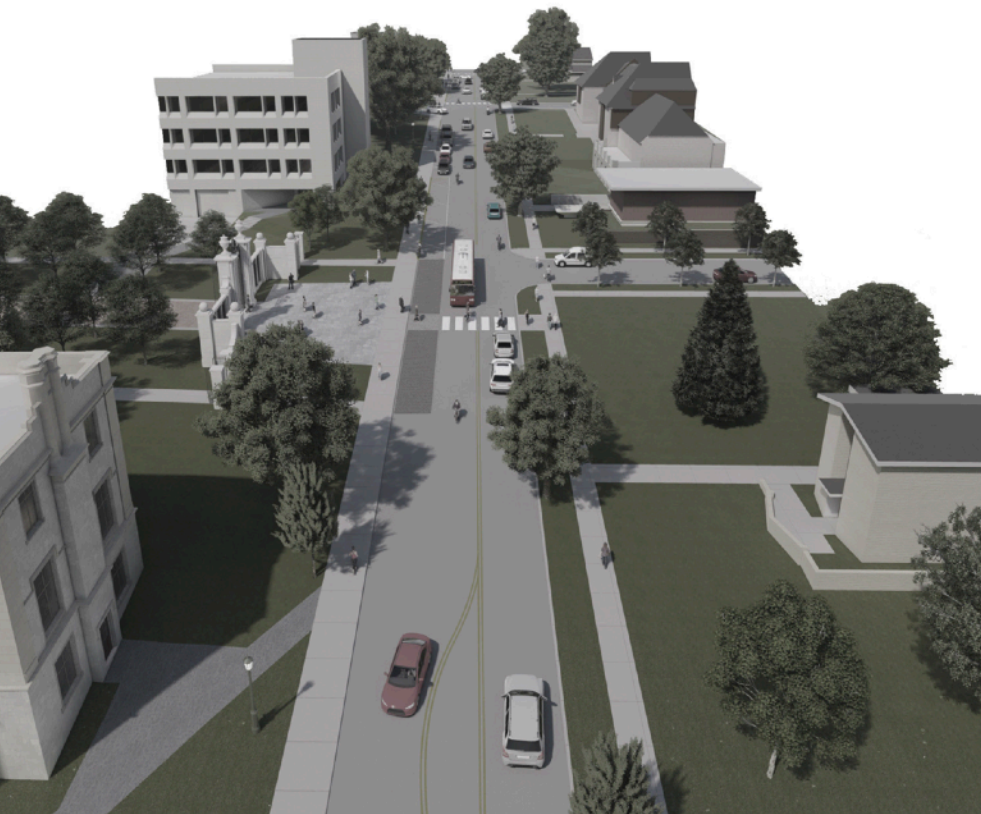

Campus Loop



The University of Arkansas campus sits just blocks from the Razorback Regional Greenway which serves as the backbone for a regional network of over one hundred miles of shared-use paved trails. Unfortunately, the connectivity between the Greenway and campus destinations lacks adequate infrastructure to serve all ages and abilities of users. The campus needs a contiguous loop of multi-use paved trail to envelope the campus core and allow for efficient circular flow, for transportation and recreation, for the community.

The new Maple Street is articulated through a series of spaces including a grand urban room at the campus gate, anchoring a landscaped pedestrian walk and cycle track. The central urban room extends Campus Walk across Maple to a new tree-lined edge.

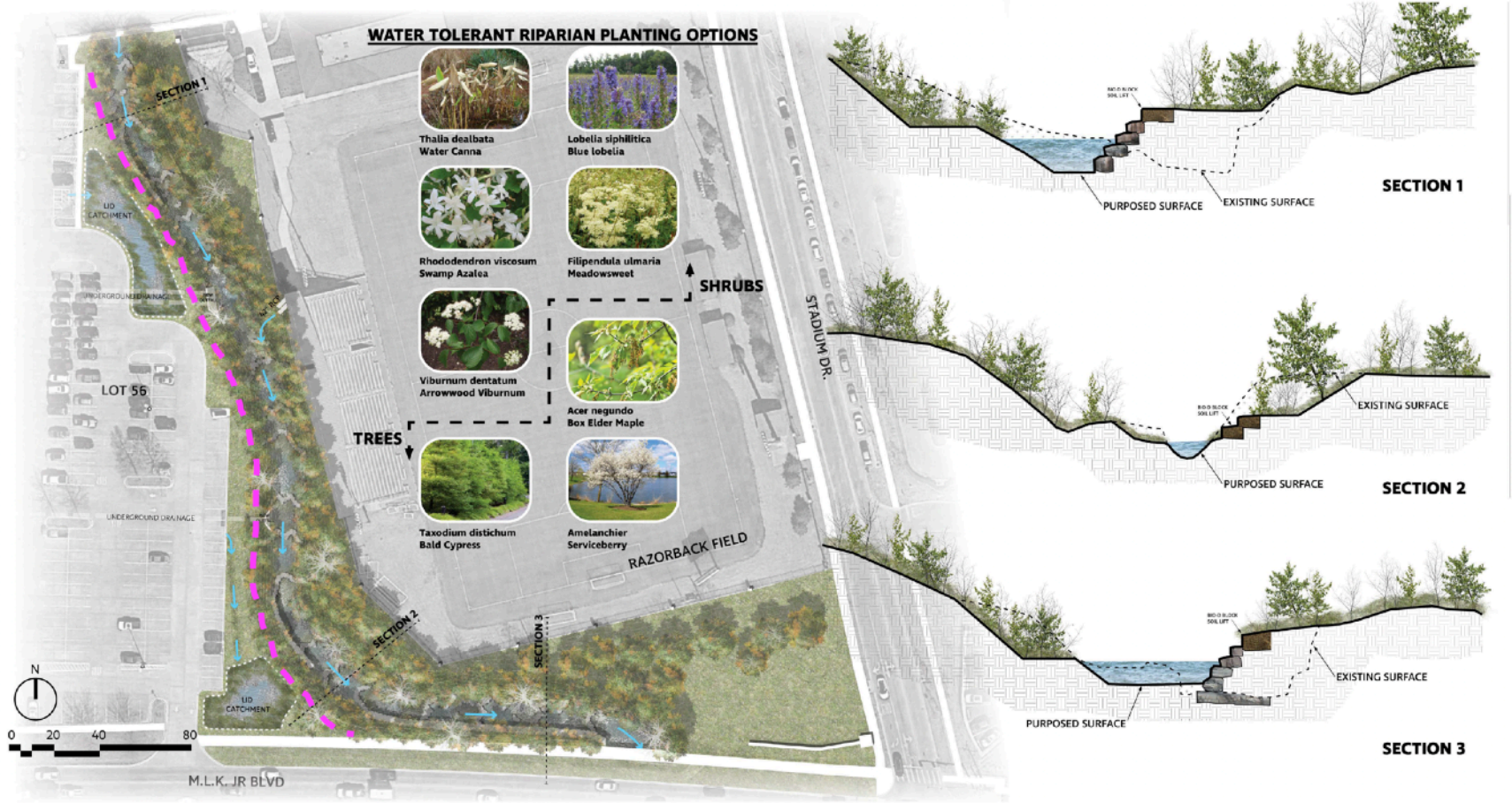


- The Fayetteville Traverse will be a soft-surface trail loop (~20 miles) that starts and finishes on the UA campus while incorporating:

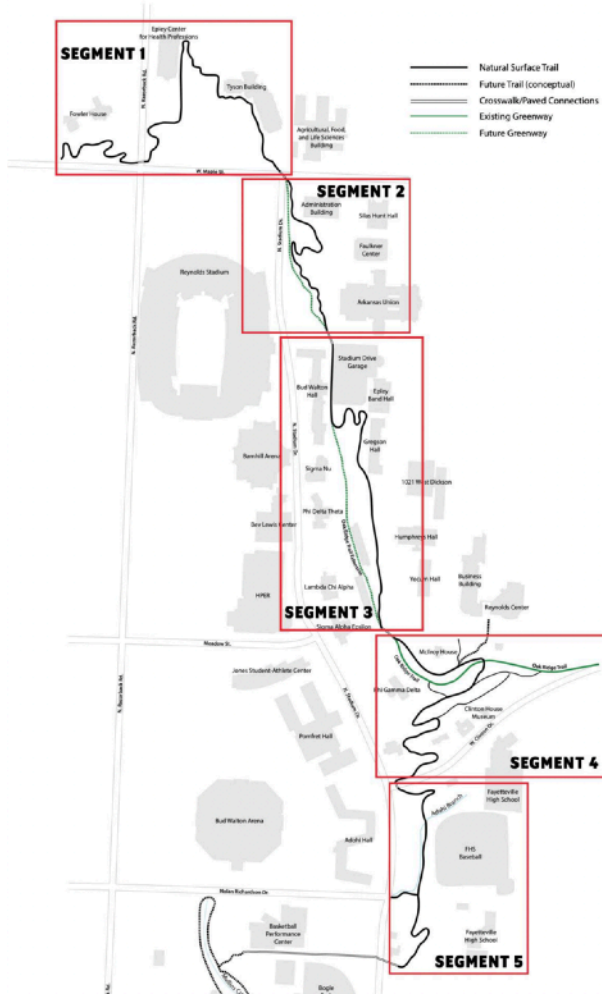

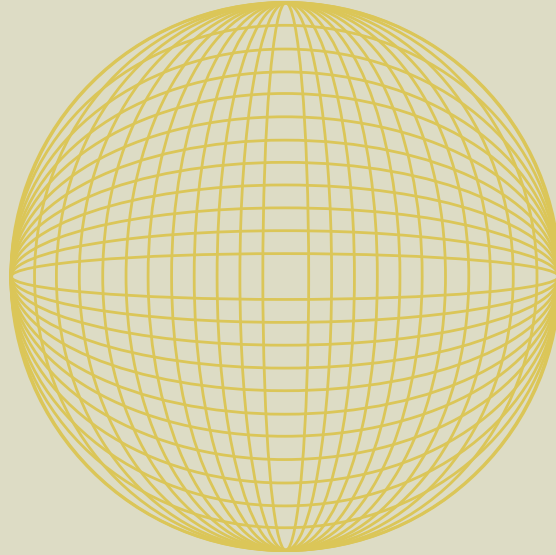
