90% DIVERSION BY 2040

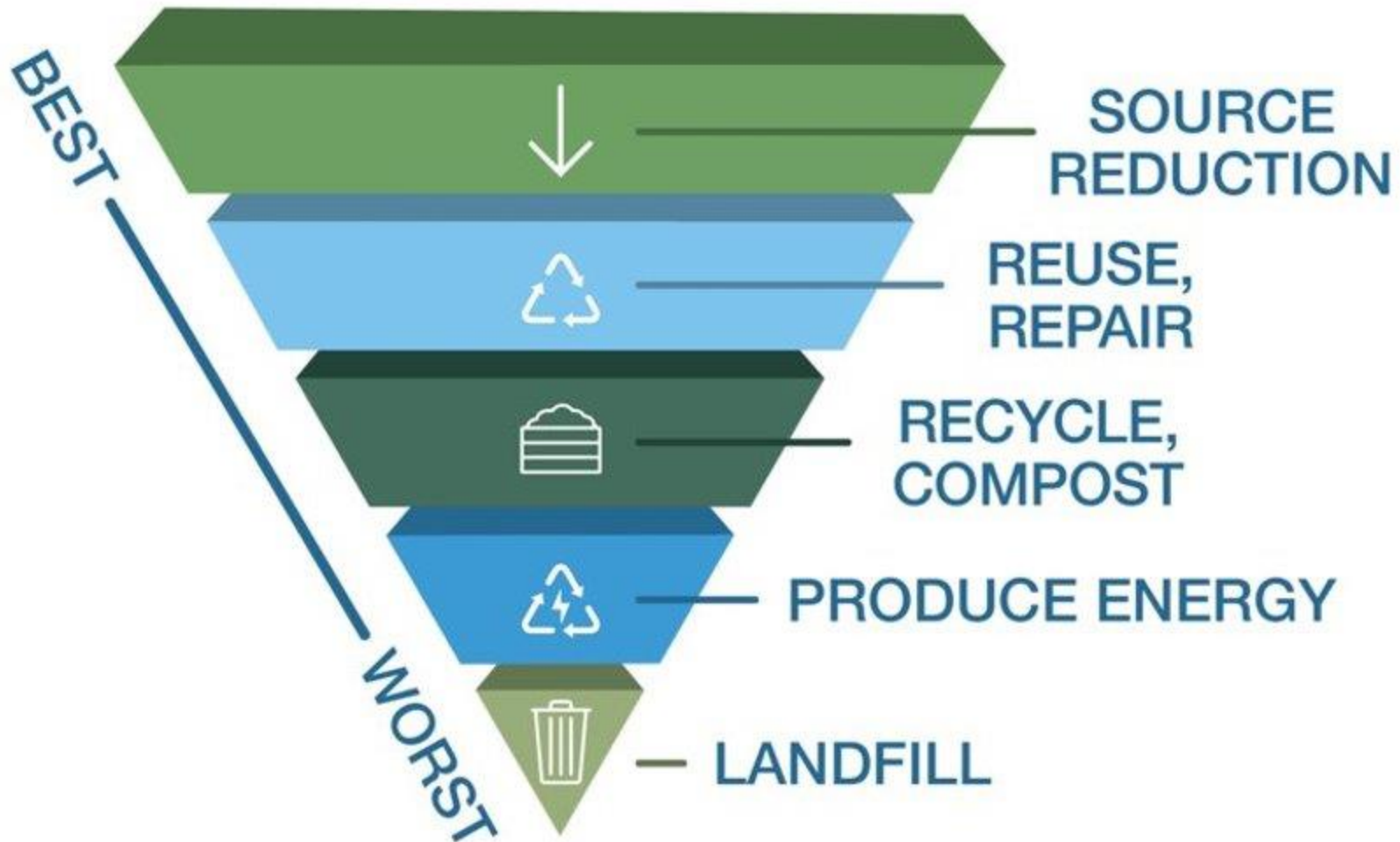
The proposed zero waste benchmarks are:

- 2028 → 50% diversion rate
- 2034 → 70% diversion rate
- 2040 → 90% diversion rate

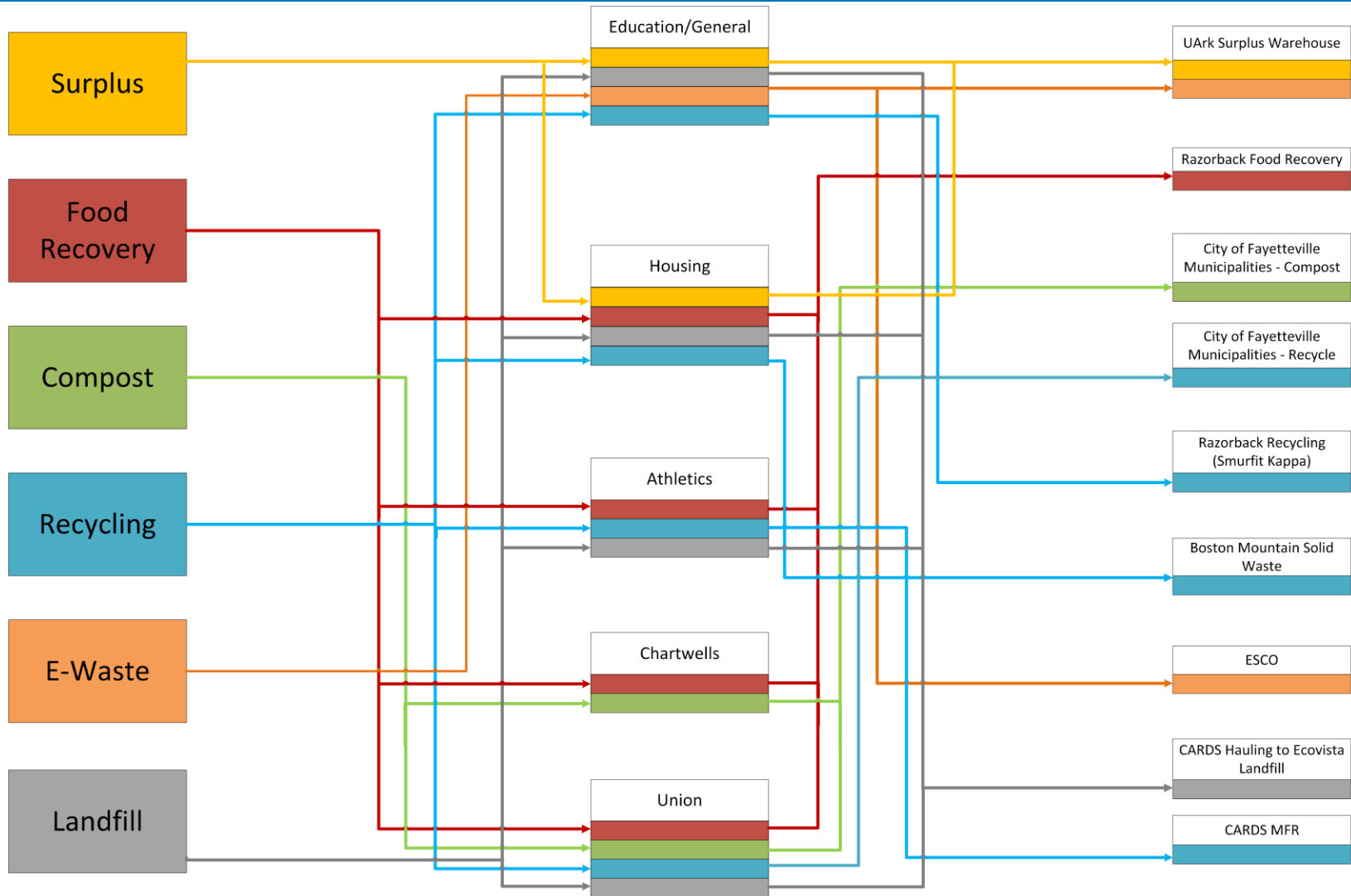
DIVERSION vs AVERSION

Waste diversion is the repurposing of goods in some shape or form, while waste aversion is the practice of avoiding wasteful goods entirely. For example, one could divert a plastic bottle by recycling it, or avert it completely by bringing one's own bottle.

WASTE HIERARCHY



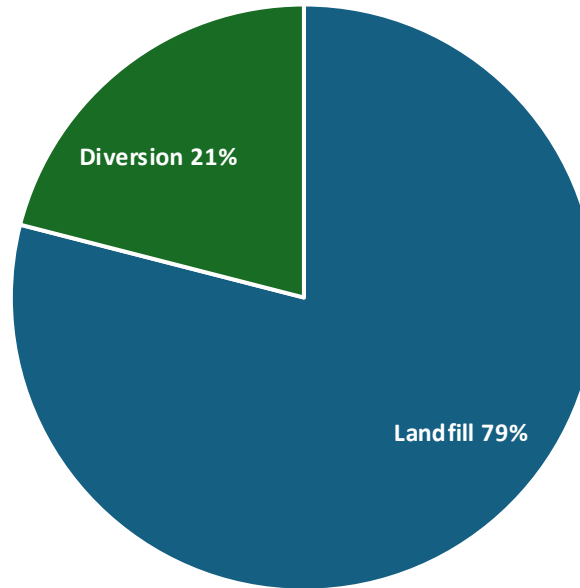
WASTE FLOW



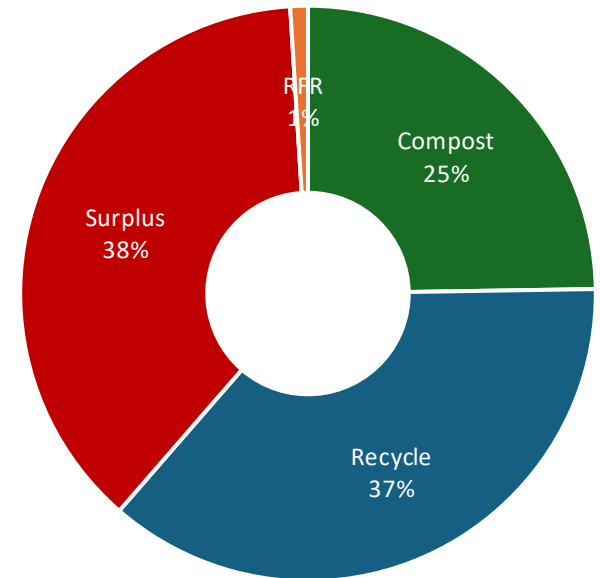

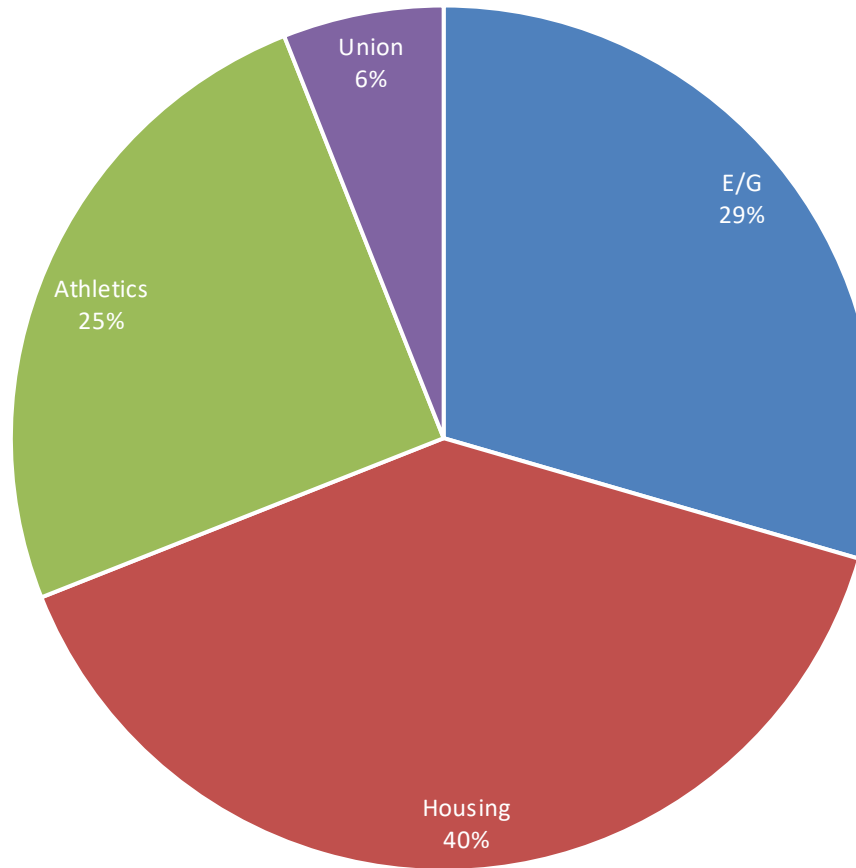

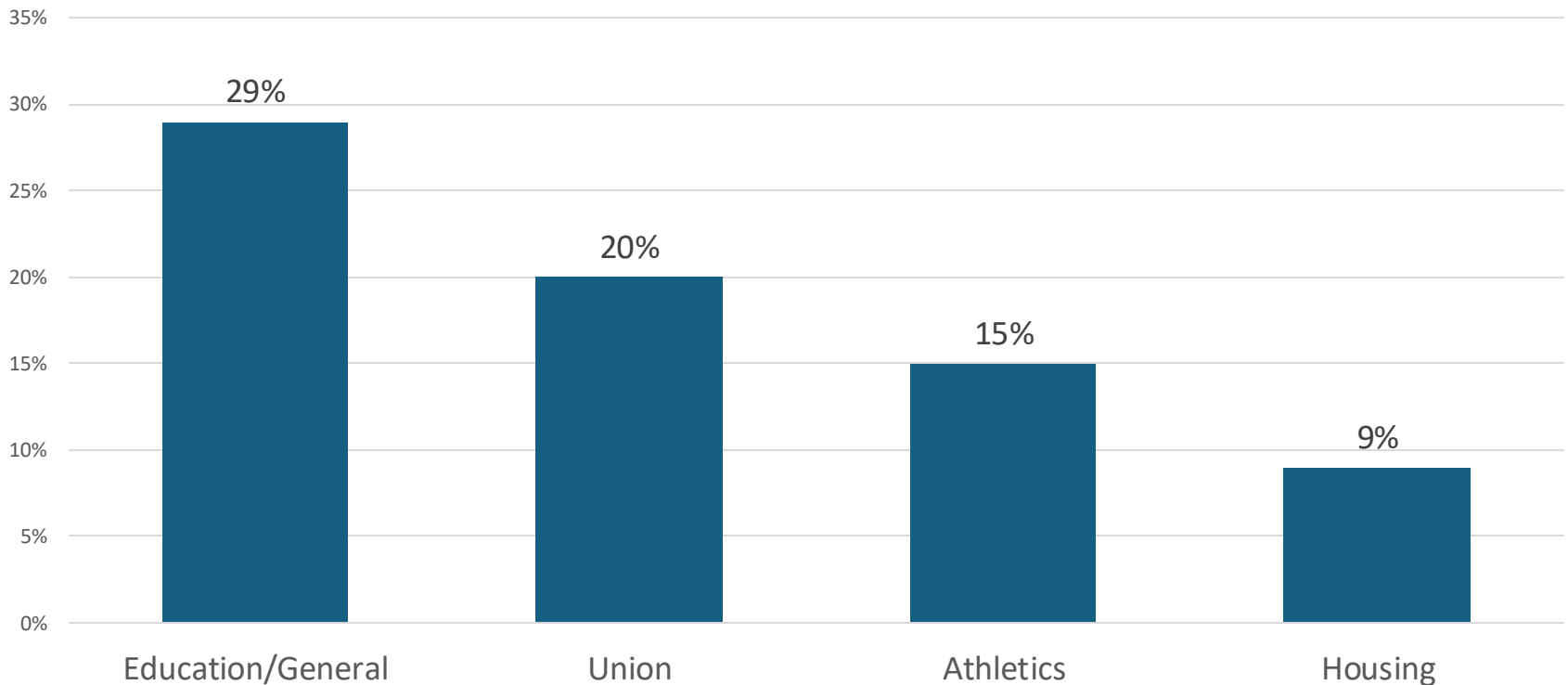

FY2024 Rate of Diversion in UA Units

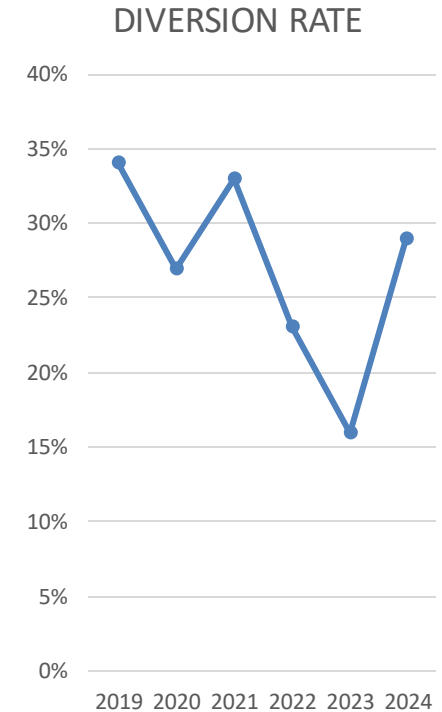
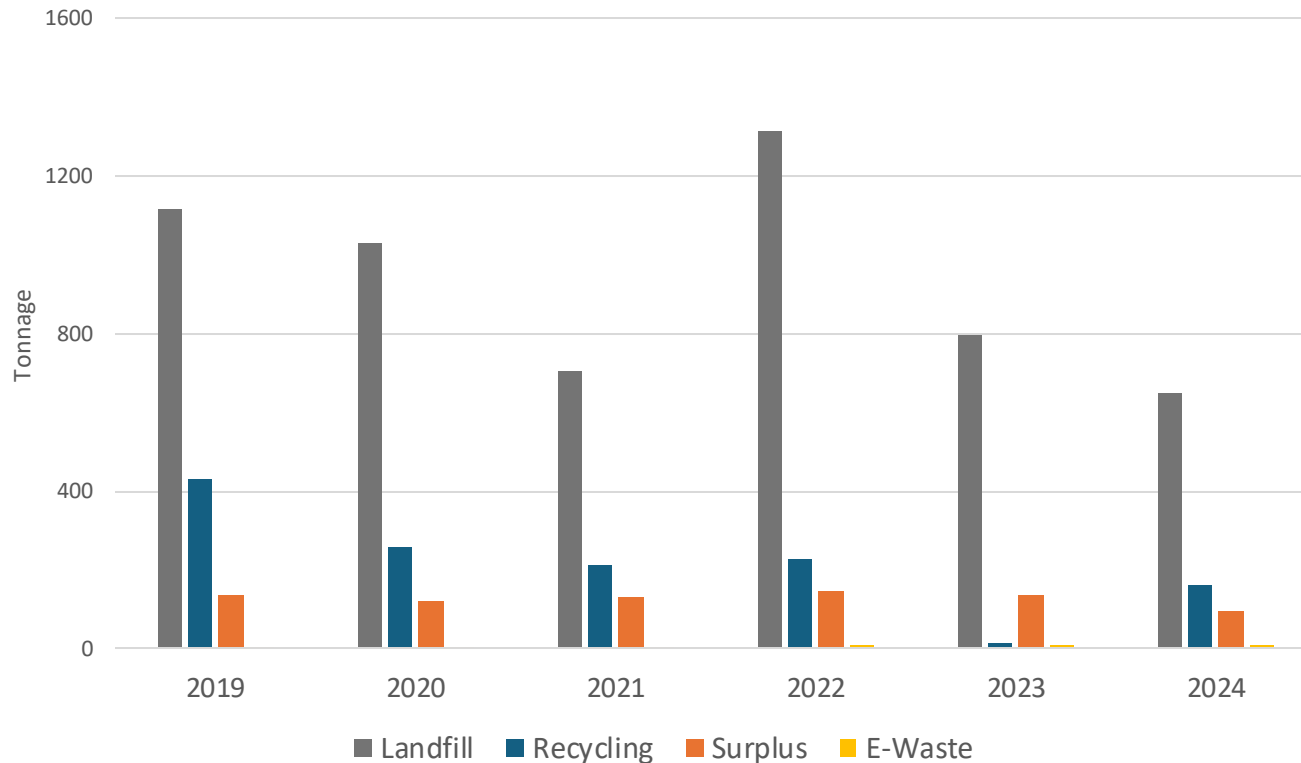

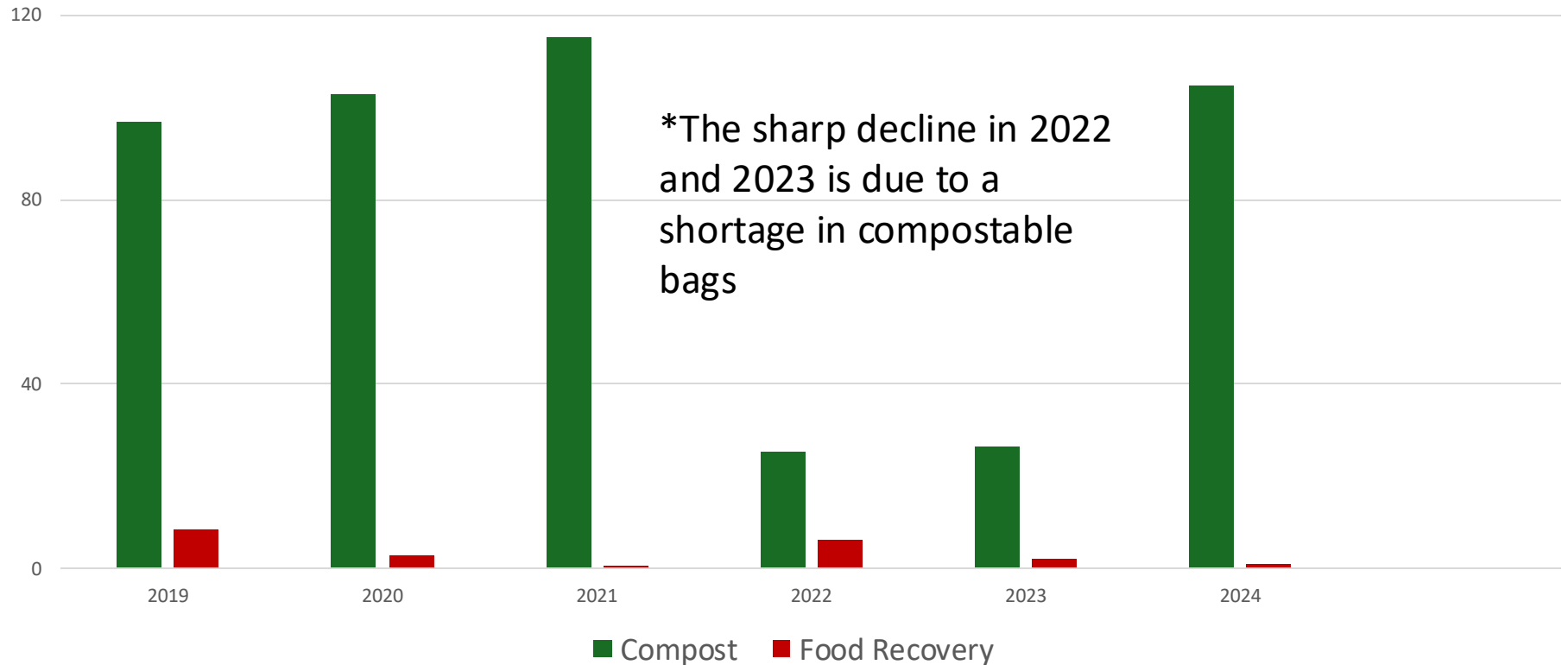

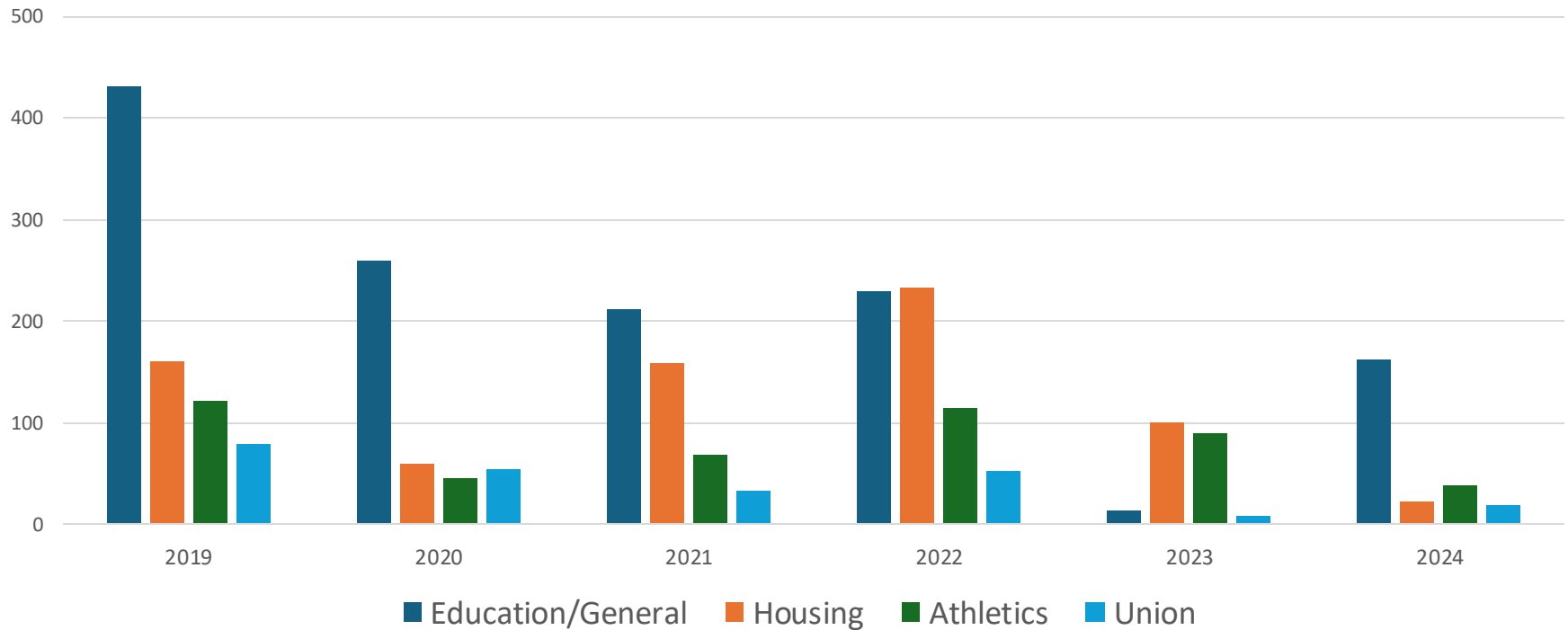
On July 1st, 2023, the U of A began using CARDS Holdings, Inc. for waste and recycling pickup, instead of Waste Management.

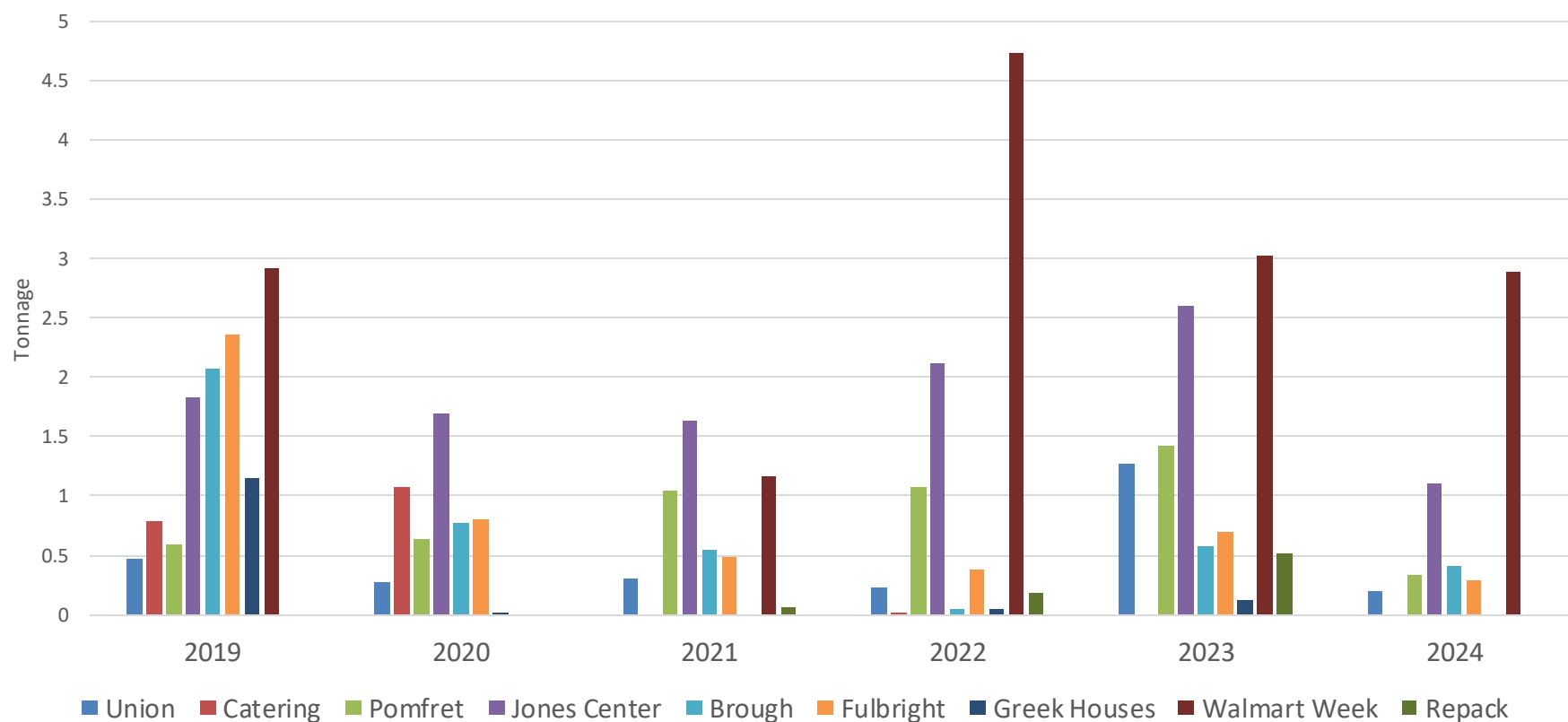

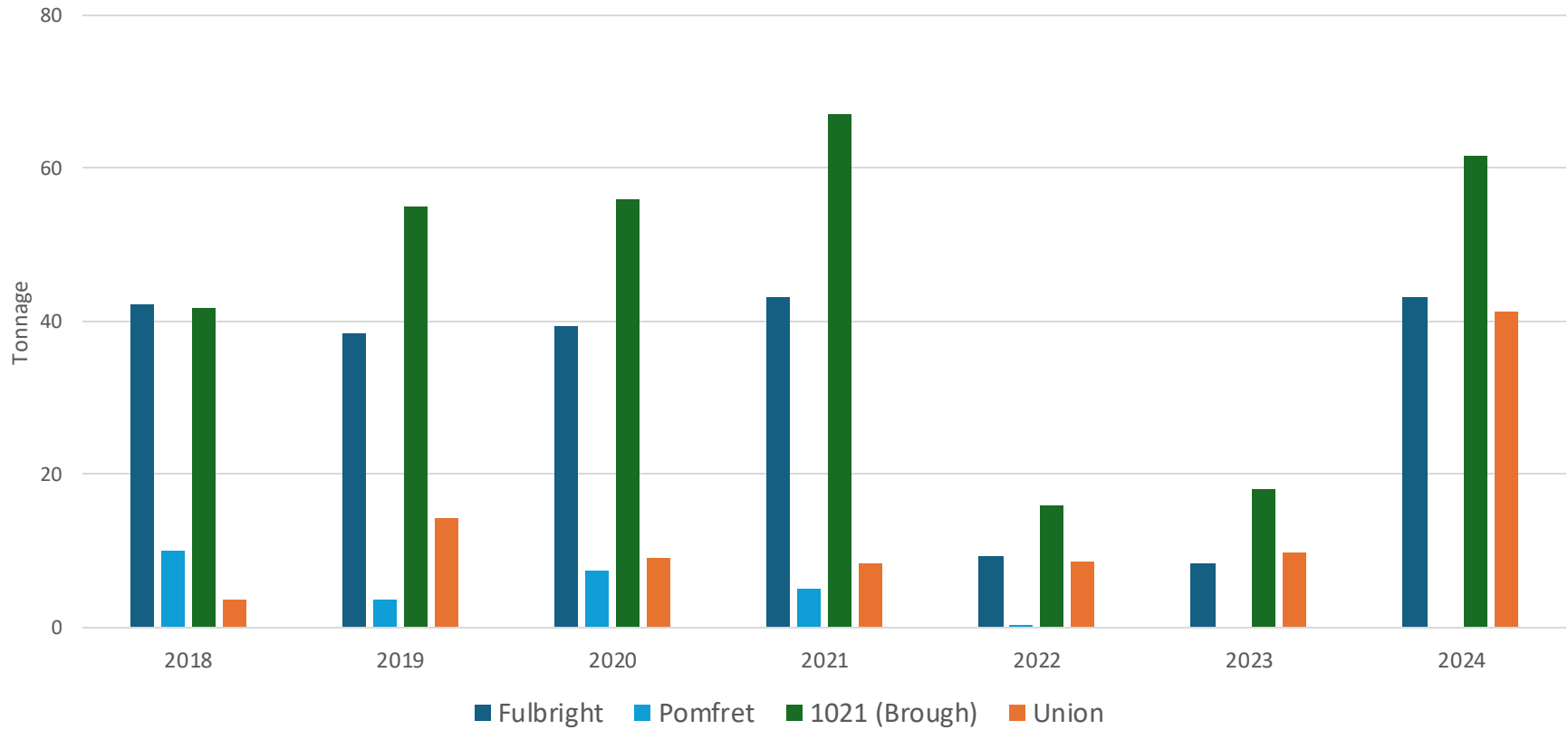

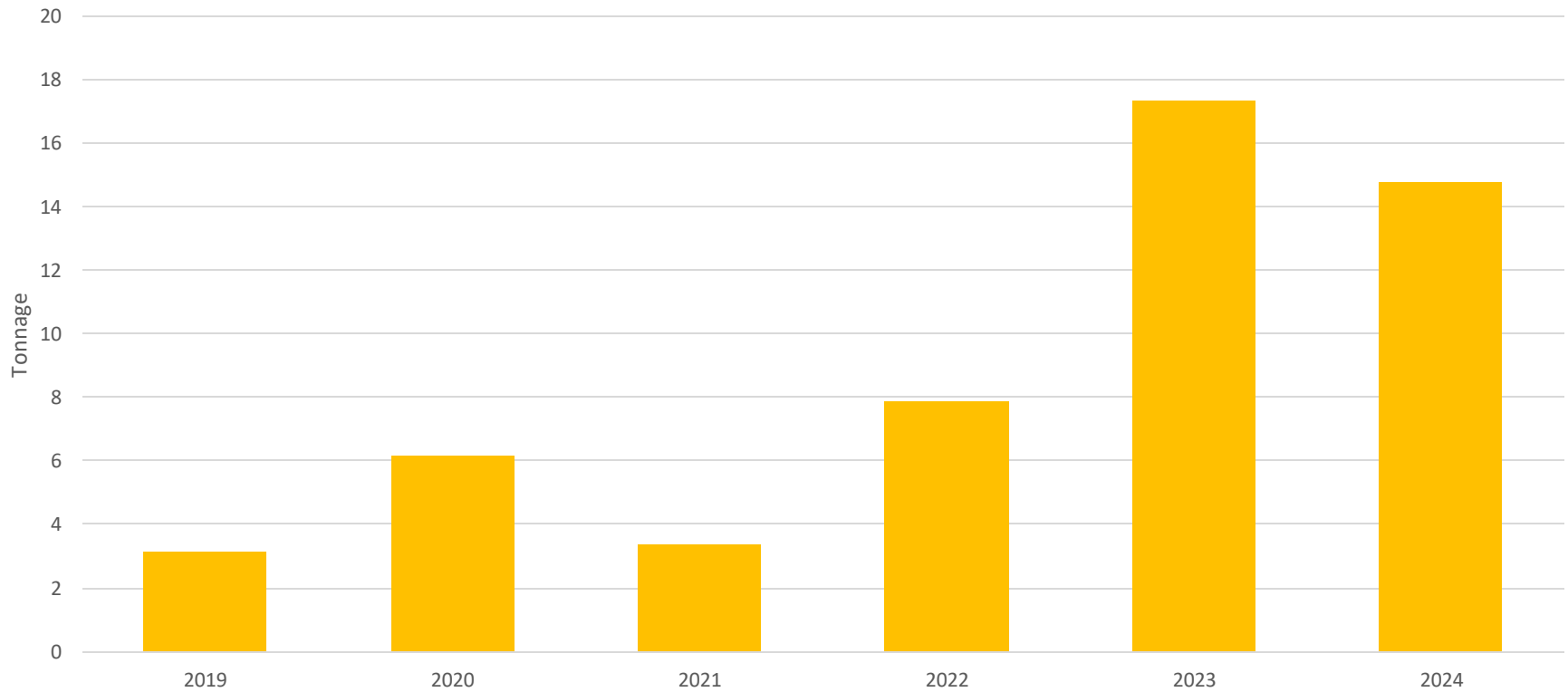

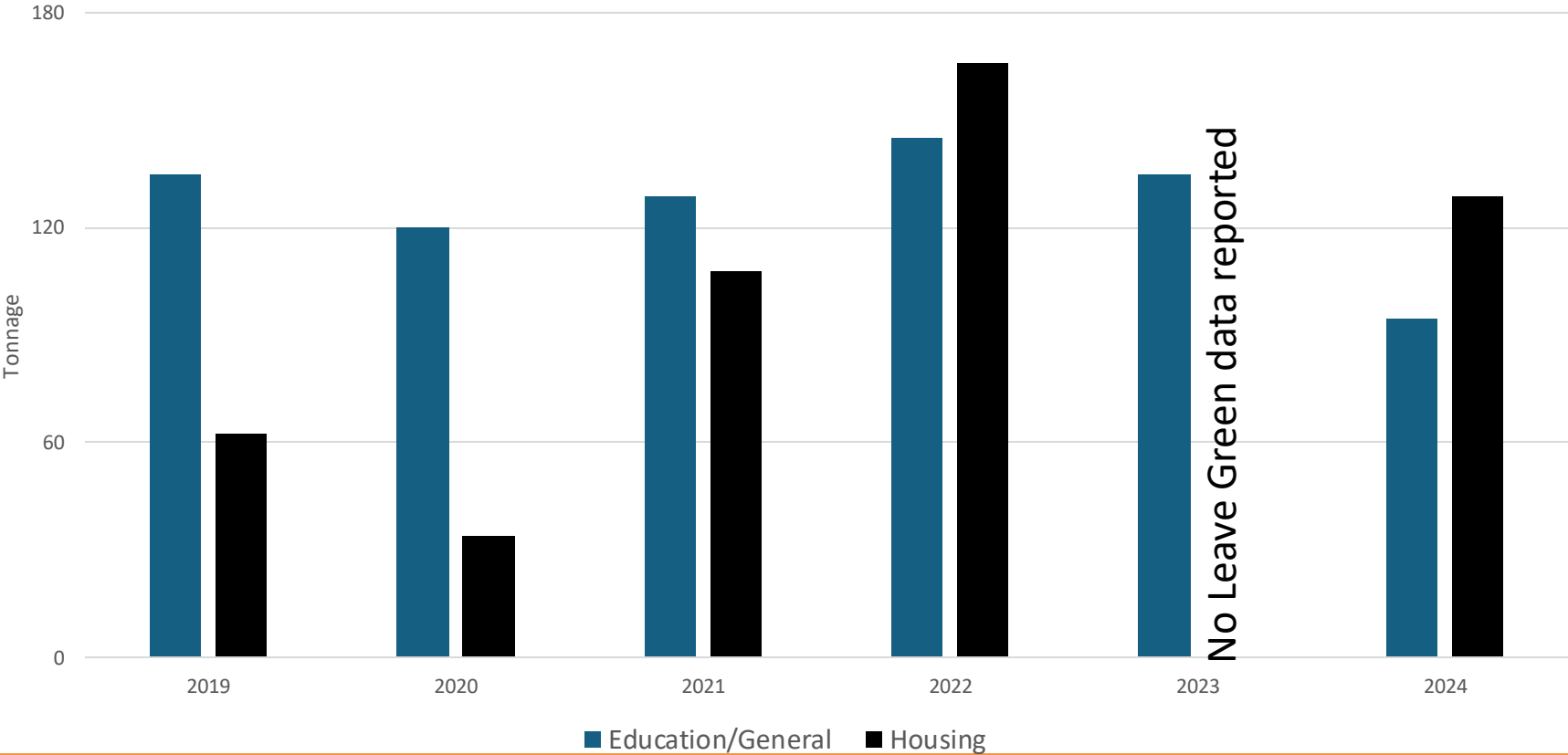
